The Program for the Study of Modern Ukraine, Canadian Institute of Ukrainian Studies, the University of Alberta and the Institute of Ethnology of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine cordially invite you to a book launch of Vol.2 of the collected works of Mykhailo Zubryts'kyi (1856-1919). Father Zubryts'kyi was a leading ethnographer, historian, and national activist of the Boiko region of the Carpathians. The volume, edited by Dr. Vasyl Sokil, contains Zubryts'kyi's autobiography, diaries, letters, and personal papers, as well as scholarly works about Zubryts'kyi. Speakers will include Dr. Frank Sysyn, editor in chief, Dr. Sokil, Dr. Stepan Pavliuk, director of the Institute, Father Bohdan Prach, rector of the Ukrainian Catholic University, Dr. Yaroslav Hrytsak, director of the Program, and authors of the scholarly contributions.
